

ARVON TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

AUGUST 3, 2026 DRAFT

CALL TO ORDER: Supervisor Jay Fish called the Regular Board meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. at the Arvon Township Fire Hall on August 3, 2026.

ROLL CALL OF MEMBERS PRESENT: Jay Fish-Supervisor, Lisa Marinich-Clerk, Krystal Eliason-Treasurer, Robert Janda-Trustee, Keith Erickson-Trustee.

MINUTES APPROVAL: Erickson motioned, seconded by Janda to approve July 6, 2026 minutes. All in favor, motion passed.

AGENDA APPROVAL: Eliason motioned, seconded by Janda to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion passed.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Pat Janik gave the board members a letter that Marinich emailed her that Marinich found. A letter that Ken Anderson wrote and the board approved to be sent to SNB, Rogala and Daavettila back in 2017. This letter is asking access to the townships parcel adjoining Rogala's property on Vick's Road. This letter was written by Anderson. Marinich let her know that she probably mailed out the letters for Anderson.

PLANNING COMMISSION UPDATE: Strohshein let the board know that there will be a work study August 13th. They will be working on short term rentals and data centers. She would like these topics on the next month's agenda.

OLD BUSINESS: The Township board approved Foster Swift Attorney's last month. On July 30, 2026, Fish and Marinich had a phone conference with them regarding Vick's Road and access to public property.

NEW BUSINESS: The Arvon Womens Fire Auxiliary hosted a Polaris ATV dealership. They brought fire fighter ATV's so the fire department could test them out. The ATV's are equipped for rugged roads and they carry water. The night of the presentation a fire broke out nearby and the fire dept got to use one of the ATV's to put out the fire. The Auxiliary has \$45,000.00 that they have raised throughout the years. They would like to put that money towards one of these ATV's. After discussion, Janda motioned, seconded by Erickson to approve paying the balance. The total bill is \$76,031.05. The township will pay the difference. All in favor, motion passed. Fish let the board know that he contacted Talen Mining Co. about possibly giving funds towards the ATV.

JIM FEDIE: Fedie finished the L-4029. Need board approval and signatures from Marinich and Fish. Eliason motioned, seconded by Janda to approve the L-4029. All in favor, motion passed.

MAIL CALL: The Skanee dump is meant only for leaves, branches, stumps. People are starting to abuse it again. It was closed years ago, then reopened. After discussing the issue, Erickson

motioned, seconded by Eliason to gate it back up and close it to the public. All in favor, motion passed.

Marinich let the board know that the Kallio Fund donated \$6,000.00 towards cemetery needs. The Arvon Township Board would like to thank the Kallio Fund for their generous donation.

TREASURERS REPORT: Eliason gave the monthly Treasurer's Report. General Fund-\$311,787.66, Ambulance/EMT Fund-\$50,238.91, Fire Fund-\$485,553.40, Liquor Fund-\$1,011.97, Road Fund-\$102,844.06. Janda motioned, seconded by Erickson, to approve the Treasurer's Report. All in favor, motion passed.

BILL APPROVAL: Eliason motioned, seconded by Janda to approve the bills. All in favor, motion passed.

NEXT MEETING DATE: Due to the Labor Day holiday, the next meeting date will be September 14, 2026 at 6:00 P.M. at the Arvon Township Fire Hall.

ADJOURN: Marinich motioned, seconded by Erickson to adjourn at 7:15 P.M. All in favor, motion passed
